

ZI-CHEM 1260 Steam Boiler Corrosion Inhibitor

HIGHLIGHTS

ZI-CHEM 1260 corrosion inhibitor is an essential component of the ZI-TECHASIA maintenance protection program of the boiler and after boiler systems.

This product a blend of 35% hydrazine and organic catalyst to increase reaction rates, particularly in the low temperature parts of the steam generating system. This product is formulated to chemically remove oxygen from feedwater, boiler water, and condensate system.

PRIMARY APPLICATIONS

The primary feed point for steam boilers is continuous to the deaerator storage vessel via stainless steel injection quill. Alternate location is the feedwater line.

FEEDING & CONTROL

ZI-CHEM 1260 should be injected to boiler or pre-boiler added using a chemical metering pump with liquid end constructed of suitable materials. These include PVC, polypropylene, viton, Teflon and stainless steel.

The dosage will depend on the operating conditions and the chemistry of the water being treated. The normal dosage of treatment is regulated to maintain an excess of 0.05 – 0.5 mg/L of hydrazine as N₂H₄ in the feed water.

Your ZI-TECHASIA technical field specialist will recommend the most appropriate dosage for your particular application on an ongoing basis.
